

# McDevitt Summer Internship Grant Program

From its inception, a central focus of the McDevitt Center for Creativity and Innovation has been integrating, promoting, and supporting a full spectrum of experiential learning and the kinds of high-impact co-curricular programs that dramatically enhance student engagement and learning.

High-caliber internships are among the most important of these co-curricular programs. They provide students with significant work experience, involving real responsibility and initiative which is related to their academic work and tied to their professional goals. As such, these internships enrich students' education and help to launch remarkable careers.

In recognition of the critical value of quality, internships for our students, their departments, and Le Moyne College, the McDevitt Center for Creativity and Innovation has developed the McDevitt Summer Internship Grant Program. This program will enhance Le Moyne's support for student internships, especially in the liberal arts, by providing grants of \$3,000 to twenty students per year who are majoring or minoring in Computer Science, Management/Information Systems, Philosophy, Physics, and Religious Studies and who secure high-impact internships.

## Application Deadline

---

Twenty (\$3,000) grants will be awarded for summer 2014 internships. The deadline for application submission is **Monday, April 21, 2014**.

Completed applications must be submitted to the McDevitt Center, RH 442. Applications submitted after the deadline will be considered on a case-by-case basis and only if funds are still available. ## The Grant Process

### 1. Research Internship Opportunities

Students are encouraged to research internship opportunities that support their personal and professional development. Preference will be given to students who secure high-impact internships and to students who secure internships outside of the central New York area. ### 2. Apply for the Grant

Submit your application materials by the date stated above. All applications will be reviewed by the grant selection committee made up of Le Moyne faculty and staff. (See attached document for detailed application information.)

### 3. Award Notification

After the committee has met and made the award decisions, you will be contacted. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision by Friday, May 2, 2014.

### 4. Grant Recipient Details

In order to receive grant funds, successful applicants must provide documentation that they have been awarded the internship for which they applied and that they have accepted the internship. Unless other arrangements are requested, grants will be disbursed by check in one payment.
