# **Eligibility**

- New York State resident (one year or more);
- Historically underrepresented (African-American, Hispanic/Latino, Native American, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander) or economically disadvantaged (documentation must be provided)
- A full-time student (12 or more credit hours) Intend to pursue a major/career in the STEM fields and/or the licensed professions

Students who do not meet the above criteria may be admitted on a probationary basis subject to CSTEP oversight and review



### Requirements

- Maintain a grade-point average of 2.5 or above
- Meet with CSTEP staff three times each semester Develop and maintain an academic plan
- Participate in workshops, conferences, internships,
- Research projects or other enrichment activities as outlined by the program.
