

In order to comply with applicable New York State guidance and the policies of Le Moyne College (the "College"), all individuals (including, but not limited to, students, faculty, staff, and visitors) electing to attend commencement ceremonies at the College on _____, 2021 are required to either supply a negative COVID-19 test that was conducted within applicable timeframes or submit to COVID-19 testing prior to admission to the commencement ceremony. By signing below, the undersigned acknowledges and consents to the individual identified below (the "Individual") submitting to COVID-19 testing prior to admission to the commencement ceremony. The decision to physically attend the College's commencement ceremony is voluntary, as is the signing of this document, the terms of which are set forth below. However, if you choose not to sign this document, the College will not be able to permit you to enter or remain on the College's campus. Consent to Share Information; Acknowledgments and Assumptions of Risk. The Individual acknowledges and agrees that he or she is at least 18 years of age and agrees and consents as follows as of the date that this document is signed:

- the Individual will submit to COVID-19 testing as scheduled and, in the manner, determined by the College, which testing will occur on the day of the commencement ceremony, prior to admission;
- the Individual authorizes the College to collect the Individual's COVID-19 test sample for, among other things, observation, testing, and all other purposes associated with COVID-19 testing;
- the College is authorized, if required in the College's sole and reasonable discretion, to provide the Individual's identifying information (including name, date of birth, contact information, or other identifying information) to other third parties that may assist with the testing and to record, verify and/or convey the Individual's test results;
- the College's designated personnel or contractors are authorized to review the COVID-19 test results and with determining what measures, if any, may be appropriate in order to comply with applicable policies or laws regarding the prevention of the spread of COVID-19;
- the Individual will sign any other forms which may be required by the College for the further disclosure or release of any of the Individual's information in connection with the COVID-19 testing and/or COVID-19 testing results; and
- the College (or its designated personnel or contractor) may, in its discretion and to the extent permitted or required by law, provide information of or relating to the Individual's COVID-19 testing - including testing results - to county, state, or any other governmental agency or their designated contractors for purposes of monitoring and/or preventing the spread of COVID-19.

As with any medical test, there is a potential for a false positive or false negative COVID-19 test result. As such, the College is not responsible for the accuracy or inaccuracy of the results. The Individual understands and agrees that the College will take measures based on the results and that the College has no duty to contest the accuracy of the Individual's test results. The Individual further agrees that, in the event that the Individual's test results indicate that the Individual is positive for COVID-19, the Individual will comply with applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, guidance and directives, as well as

the College's policies and protocols. In the event that the Individual tests positive for COVID-19, the College will not admit the Individual to the commencement ceremony and will instruct the Individual to leave campus.

The Individual also agrees to accept and assume all risks related to or in connection with the Individual submitting to the COVID-19 testing, including but not limited to, inaccurate testing and potential personal injury in the event that the Individual performs the testing on themselves in a manner that is not consistent with instructions from the College's designated personnel/contractors or as set forth in the test kit. By way of example, test kits that utilize a nasal swab or saliva test may have specific directions that must be followed to ensure proper testing and avoid physical harm.

The Individual has been informed about the purpose, procedures, possible benefits and risks of this COVID-19 testing and has been given the opportunity to ask questions relating to such testing. The Individual voluntarily agrees to submit to testing for COVID-19 and agrees that the Individual is solely responsible for this decision.
