DURATION OF STUDY

You can choose to study abroad for a semester or full year at Loyola University Andalucía.

The Fall semester runs September to December and the Spring semester runs January to June.

GRADING SYSTEM

The Spanish grading system uses a scale from 0 to 10, where 0 is the lowest grade and 10 is the highest. A grade of 5 or higher is a pass.

8.1-9	Remarkable
7.1-8	Remarkable
6.1-7	Good
5-6	Sufficient
0-4.9	Fail

SPANISH COURSES

Loyola University Andalucía offers a free, 10-hour intensive Spanish course worth 1 ECTS during the first week of the semester. Students can also opt to enroll in a semester-long Spanish course or cultural workshop.

Study Abroad Applications

- Attend a Study Abroad Information Session one year before you intend to study abroad. Then, complete the **Request for Study Abroad Approval form** for at least two options. Return completed forms to the Office of Inclusive Excellence and Global Education in RH 344.
- If approved, we will notify Loyola University Andalucía and you will receive an email with a link to an online application. You will need to submit a number of documents including two passport-style photos, a copy of the photo-ID page in your passport, and proof of medical insurance.

COURSE SELECTION

Students are required to complete a **Course Approval form** before registering for courses at their study abroad institution. **Failure to complete this form may result in loss of credit.**

Most courses at Loyola University Andalucía are worth 3-6 ECTS (European Credit Transfer System). To maintain full-time status, students should take between 24 to 30 ECTS (approximately 12 to 15 U.S. credits).



BUDDY PROGRAM

You will be assigned to a group of students from Loyola University Andalucía who will assist you prior to and during your stay in Córdoba or Seville. They can help you with choosing courses, finding accommodation, and getting used to your surroundings.

Costs

ACCOMMODATION: Student accommodation is not available at Loyola University Andalucía. They do, however, have agreements with agencies in both Córdoba and Seville to place exchange students in housing.

LIVING EXPENSES: Students should budget **€600 (~\$660) per month** to cover accommodation, meals, and public transport use.

Health Insurance

All exchange students are required to provide proof of health insurance for the duration of their stay in Spain. The policy must cover all medical costs, including accidents, emergencies, and repatriation.

Note that Loyola University Andalucía's registration fee includes insurance which covers accidents on campus and counselling.

Visa Information

Students studying in Spain for a period longer than 90 days are required to obtain a Student Visa. In order to apply for the visa, you will need to pay a **\$160 fee** and submit the following documents to your nearest Spanish Consulate or Embassy:

- Visa application form
- Valid passport
- Passport-sized photograph
- Letter of acceptance from Loyola University Andalucía
- Proof of health insurance
- Proof of finances. You will need to document that you have access to at least **\$700 for every month** you will be in Spain.
