The Master of Science for Teachers (M.S.T.) is an accelerated 39-credit program which leads to New York state initial and professional certification. The program is completed in 21 months (considered five semesters, including summer session). Clinically rich practicum experiences are required throughout the program with a final semester of full-time student teaching.
